Purpose

The Quality Chapter Distinction Award is designed to recognize chapters who have met the requirements of being actively involved in Business Professionals of America. These chapters have planned programs, an approved budget, elected officers and more.

Deadlines for Recognition

National All activities must occur between the dates of April 2, 2017 and April 1, 2018.


To Qualify

Complete **ALL** of the following Activities

- Elect and be led by chapter officers.
- Conduct monthly chapter meetings.
- Have an integrated program of leadership training and practices.

Complete **FOUR** of the following SEVEN Activities

- Plan and adhere to a budget
- Participate in the BPA Cares Program.
- Nationally register two advisors for your chapter.
- Increase chapter membership over the previous year.
- Participate in a chapter, state, or national fund-raising program.
- Participate in a conference outside the local chapter.
- Participate in the Torch Awards Program.
